Our school rules in times of the coronavirus pandemic - in order that we stay healthy



ALWAYS

- If I'm sick, I'll stay at home and contact a doctor.
- I observe the sanitary regulations at school and elsewhere.

BEFORE SCHOOL

• I stand ALONE on a marker in front of the entrance under the roof and I wait until the supervision lets me into school.

IN THE AISLES

• I always go right and keep a distance from my predecessor. The arrows on the floor help me with this.

BEFORE CLASS

- I wait at a distance until the teacher asks me to go into the classroom.
- I sit down on my seat and I hang my jacket over the back of my chair.

DURING CLASS

- I work and have breakfast in my own place.
- I may just move around the classroom on my own. I raise my hand and ask the teacher's permission.
- I only touch my own stuff.
- If I have questions about a task, I'll wait until a helper chair becomes vacant in front of the board.

DURING BREAK

- I leave the classroom at the signal from the teacher and go straight to my break area.
- I am waiting for the supervision to let me out.

- When playing, reading or having breakfast, I always pay attention to the distance from others.
- I only leave the break with the permission of the supervisor.
- As I walk in, I stand on the markings and wait for the supervisory signal.

IN THE TOILET

- If possible, I only go to the toilet during breaks. The supervision is careful that only one girl and one boy from my group are allowed to go.
- I push the cone in front of the toilet entrance with my foot to show that it is taken.
- I wash my hands thoroughly.
- I push the cone to the side in front of the toilet entrance to show that it is free.
- I go straight back to my group.

AFTER CLASS

- I clean up my place. The chairs remain on the floor.
- I am waiting for the teacher to let me out of the classroom.
- I walk directly to the exit and wait for the supervisory signal to leave the school building.
- I am not allowed to wait for siblings or parents in the building.
- On the way home, I also keep my distance from others.
